Two hourly sessions each week

- Print and number awareness;
- Enjoying poetry and other children's literature;
- Concept development; and
- Music and rhythm

Enjoy one-on-one time with your infant doing creative and fun activities designed to develop a basic foundation for your child's social, emotional, and educational needs.

Based on pre- and posttesting of children in this program over a five-year period of time, gains in mental and psychomotor development were more than twice what was expected. On average, for every *one* month in the program, the Early Preschool Program children showed more than *two* months of growth compared to the parents and children not in the program. This program, called "Enriching a Child's Literacy Environment" (ECLE), was validated by the Program Effectiveness Panel, U.S. Department of Education.
